Course Description

The Spring Course is devoted to a review of the most compelling topics discussed during Digestive Disease Week® 2021. - Examine the diagnostic and expanded therapeutic capabilities of ERCP and EUS to detect and treat disorders of the hepatobiliary tract, pancreas, and luminal gastrointestinal tract and to detect and manage suspected small bowel bleeding
