**Statement of Need:** It can be difficult for many physicians to stay up to date with recent management and treatment paradigms for common GI and Liver diseases. This course will offer a review of new diagnostic and therapeutic modalities available that will benefit the care of their patients. There is a current need for safe and efficacious technologies and techniques for the endoscopic management of GERD, gastroparesis, obesity with GI tract cancers and other GI disorders, without having to resort to surgical procedures. The most important issue for a gastroenterologist is awareness of future and current changes that may meaningfully impact the care of patients or current practice. Adoption of worthy new technologies and techniques will increase the scope of our practice as a specialty, as well as benefit our patients.
